



WGPPS Covid-19 precautions

Public (including students): please do not come out to events if:

- You have any signs and symptoms of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, sore throat, runny nose, etc)
- You or anyone in your household travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days
- You or anyone in your household has been in contact in the last 14 days with someone who has been investigated or confirmed to be a case of COVID-19
- You are currently being investigated as a suspected case of Covid-19
- If you have tested positive for Covid-19 within the last 14 days

Events/programs

- **Indoors:** the City of Calgary has passed the temporary Face Coverings Bylaw. The bylaw requires all staff, members, patrons, etc. to wear a face covering (mask) in indoor facilities
- **Outdoors:** everyone attending events, educational programs etc. outside will be required to wear a non-medical mask when closer than 2 meters to another person
- Contact details of people attending Society events will be collected and kept by the Society.
- If anyone attending these events later tests positive for Covid-19 we ask that he/she let the Society know as soon as possible. The Society will then notify people who had contact with the person through the Society in the previous 14 days. In the interest of privacy we will not disclose the name of the person unless permission to do this is given.

Naturalists/group leaders:

- If staff that has been engaging with the public or other staff/Board/members and test positive for Covid-19, he/she will notify the Society. The Society will then notify people who had contact with the staff member through the Society in the previous 14 days.
- Naturalists will make a list of all participants and their contact details at events in case of the need to contact them.
- Naturalists will sanitise tools and other supplies/materials handled by people during and following events.

Any additional or altered recommendations of the Province of Alberta and City of Calgary in effect at the time of events and programs will take precedence over the above.
